Why attend?

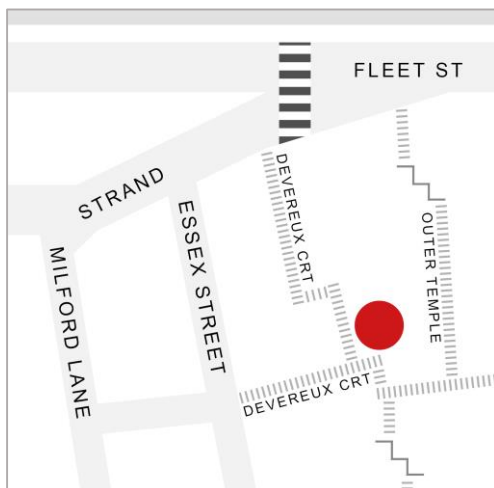
